WHAT DOES MEMBERSHIP INCLUDE?

Membership includes social activities, programs, and supportive services.

Social Activities and Programs:

WHAT DOES MEMBERSHIP INCLUDE? (CONT.)

Supportive Services:

- Drop-off or roundtrip transportation to appointments, errands, or even shopping.
 By request, a volunteer can wait for you at a doctor's office or take notes during medical appointments.
- Assistance with minor home repairs and maintenance. Volunteers can help with changing light bulbs, batteries in smoke detectors, clearing out closets, home filing and organizing, decluttering, light gardening, patio clean up, etc.
- **Technology support**. Volunteers can help set up computers, printers, TV remotes, mobile phones, iPads, etc.
- Checking-in. Volunteers can make regular calls or friendly visits to members who are unable to leave their home or attend events.
- Assistance with temporary pet care.
 Volunteers can provide pet care on a temporary basis or accompany you and your pet to a veterinarian.
- Special requests. Call us and we'll see if we can help with special requests!
